

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a length of Plympton Hill at Plymouth, in the District of South Hams.

If the order is made, the stopping up will be authorised only to enable development as permitted by South Hams District Council, under references 7_49/2426/06/O, 4175/21/VAR and 0825/18/VAR.
